RECEIPT OF REQUEST FOR COSTING OF ELECTION COMMITMENT

The Department of Finance and the Department of the Treasury have been asked by the Prime Minister to jointly cost the following election commitments under the *Charter of Budget Honesty Act 1998*:

COA028 - Establishment of Comprehensive Cancer Centre, Queensland
COA029 - Sport Package
COA030 - Type 1 Diabetes Family Centre Incentivising Pensioners to Downsize
COA031 - Heart Centre for Children
COA032 - Incentivising Pensioners to Downsize
COA033 - Public Interest News Gathering – multicultural
COA034 - Super Home Buyer Scheme and Downsizer Contributions
COA035 - Wine Export Grants program

The costings will be completed in accordance with the *Charter of Budget Honesty: Policy Costing Guidelines – 2021*. The Guidelines are available at www.electioncostings.gov.au.

The Guidelines provide that in certain circumstances a costing may not be completed. As these requests were received on **16 May 2022** the costings may not be completed prior to polling day.


If completed prior to the election the costings will be publically released on www.electioncostings.gov.au. If a costing is unable to be completed prior to the election, a statement to this effect will be published on www.electioncostings.gov.au and, consistent with subclause 31(3) of the *Charter of Budget Honesty Act 1998*, the costing request will be taken to be withdrawn.
